Standardised Price List

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

Attended Funeral (funeral director's charges only)

£1445

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for their loved one at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£590
Collecting and transporting your loved one from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of Kevin Lownds Funeral Services) into our care.	£165
Care of your loved one before the funeral in appropriate facilities. Your loved one will rest at Kevin Lownds Funeral Services until the day of their funeral.	£50
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from oak veneer (Additional cost may be incurred where a bespoke size is required)	£450
Dressing and/or viewing of your loved one for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£35
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking your loved one direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of Kevin Lownds Funeral Services) in an appropriate vehicle	£155

Unattended Funeral

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£795
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee (2))	£995

Fees You Must Pay

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee. ¹ In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: <small>For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.</small>	£1030-£1355
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee. ² In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:	£600-£970

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
